

WEEKLY REPORT
07/29/12-08/04/12

On Friday, August 3, 2012 at approximately 11:40 p.m., Newark Police responded to the area of Kells Avenue for a report of a suspicious male pulling on door handles to cars. Officers located a male crouching near some bushes and made contact with the subject. Officers then noticed that the subject had several items on him and had dropped other items to include a cell phone. Officers then learned that there were six victims on Kells Avenue who had items stolen out of their unsecured vehicles. Property found on the subject linked him to those victims. Arrested was Kenneth Emory, w/m, DOB 08/31/82 of Wilmington, DE. He was arrested for twelve crimes including Burglary, Attempted Burglary, Theft, Attempted Theft and Trespassing.

On Monday, August 6, 2012 at approximately 11:45 p.m., a Newark Police officer attempted to stop a vehicle that was suspected to have a connection to a burglary that had just occurred in the area of East Park Place. The officer began to follow the vehicle and then attempted to conduct a traffic stop. The vehicle then fled from the officer at a high rate of speed. The vehicle was located a short time later abandoned in the area of East Main Street. It was learned that the vehicle had just been stolen out of a garage on Kells Avenue. The victim had left the garage open with the keys in the ignition. The suspect was not apprehended and the investigation is continuing.

On Tuesday, August 7, 2012, the Newark Police sent out a crime alert to residents of the City via the InformMe system. The Newark Police have seen an increase in thefts from unsecured vehicles, as well as homeowners leaving their garage doors open and having items stolen out of them. We would like to remind everyone to lock their vehicles at all times and remove any valuable items. It is also important to keep garage doors closed at all times, as homes have access to the residence by way of an interior door; this is an easy way for a criminal to enter your home undetected.
