On Wednesday, August 8, 2012 at 6:40 a.m., a burglary and theft was discovered at the Subway store located in Suburban Plaza. Surveillance video showed two suspects enter the store and remove \$650.00 from the safe. Detectives investigated and arrested an employee of the store for the crime. The second suspect is expected to be arrested shortly.

Corporal Micolucci is continuing to investigate graffiti violations. He expects to make more arrests within the next few weeks.

Our newest recruit, William Anderson, has four more weeks of academy training and will graduate the Delaware State Police Academy on September 21, 2012. Upon his return, he will begin field training.

We have begun our annual "Fall Crime Suppression" deployment. This plan was put into place in September of 2008 and has been successful in reducing the number of street robberies each year. This year we have the addition of our newly created "Special Operations Unit". This unit is staffed by three officers who are paid for by a federal grant. The unit is overseen by a sergeant. They have been extremely effective in dealing with chronic problem locations. We are in the process of attempting to obtain grant money from the state to fund a police vehicle for the unit.
