SUBJECT: Unidentified Child Found

At approximately 5:30 a.m. this morning a passing motorist found a small child wandering at the intersection of Route 4 and 896 in the City of Newark. The motorist transported the child to the WaWa at Elkton Road and Fletchwood Road and notified the Newark Police. NPD officers responded and took custody of the child.

The child is a black male, approximately 3 years old. He advises that his name is Jordan. He was wearing a lime green and yellow t shirt, grey shorts, and white socks. He was not wearing shoes.

The child, who does not appear to have any injuries, has been transported to A.I. DuPont Children's Hospital for evaluation.

A photo of the child is attached.

Police are attempting to identify and locate the parents or guardians of this child. Anyone with information about the child is asked to call Newark Police at (302) 366-7111.

The Newark Police Department affirms that all defendants are presumed innocent until proven guilty beyond a reasonable doubt.
