

WEEKLY REPORT

11/11/12-11/17/12

New Castle County Police are currently investigating a homicide that occurred in the Studio Green West Apartment complex in Newark, DE. On Monday November 12th at 9:23 p.m., County Police, Paramedics and ambulance personnel from the Aetna Fire Company responded to the 200 block of Thorn Lane for a subject who had been shot. When emergency personnel arrived, they observed an unresponsive male subject who had an apparent gunshot wound to his upper body. The victim was tended to by Paramedics and then transported by ambulance personnel to the Christiana Hospital and later pronounced dead. Multiple units from multiple agencies responded to the scene and immediately set up a perimeter, and then began canvassing the surrounding area in an attempt to gather information and locate the possible suspects. A canine team also responded to assist, but they were unsuccessful in their efforts. The suspects are described as two black males, one of which was wearing a gray hooded sweatshirt and the other a black hooded sweatshirt. Sgt. VanCampen is continuing to assist the New Castle County Police with this investigation.

Wilmington Police detectives arrested a 16 year old in connection with the September 26th reckless endangering incident that occurred in the 400 block of E. 9th Street in Wilmington. On that date Wilmington Police responded to a call for shots fired in the block. Officers located casings at the scene and obtained surveillance footage that clearly showed a suspect firing a handgun at another crowd of subjects. Two bystanders, a 65 year old female and her juvenile granddaughter, were in the line of fire and were nearly struck by the bullets. This surveillance footage was released to the media in an effort to obtain public assistance in identifying the unknown suspect. This footage was aired on Action News and other local channels. On November 14th Corporal Darryl Saunders of the Newark Police Department contacted the lead investigator, Wilmington Detective Michael Gifford, regarding this case. Corporal Saunders, the School Resource Officer for Newark High School, had reviewed the surveillance footage on Action News and believed that one of his students was the suspect. Through investigative techniques Detective Gifford was able to confirm that Nazier Johnson was the suspect seen firing a handgun in the surveillance footage. Johnson was taken into custody on November 14th at Newark High at School and charged with two counts of Reckless Endangering 1st Degree, and Possession of a Firearm During the Commission of a Felony. Johnson was turned over to his parents after being released on a \$72,000 unsecured bond.
