On Monday, February 18th at approximately 1:35 a.m., the Newark Police responded to the 100 block of East Delaware Avenue for a report of an armed robbery which had just occurred. The 24 year old male victim, a Wilmington University graduate student, reported that he was walking eastbound on East Delaware Avenue when he was grabbed from behind. The victim reported that the unknown suspect demanded his money while placing what felt like a gun to his face. The victim was then pushed to the ground and three additional suspects began to repeatedly punch the victim in the head and face. The suspects stole the victim's wallet and cell phone. The victim was able to break away from the suspects, who then fled the area. The original suspect was seen getting into a dark four door sedan and fleeing the area. The suspect with the gun was described as a light skinned black male, approximately 20 years old with a thin building and loose braids. No surveillance video is available at this time.

On Thursday, February 21st, a Deputy US Marshall conducted a security review of City Hall and the Alderman's Court. The Deputy's report of security improvements will be provided to the City Manager for review.

Planning has begun for this year's Saint Patrick's Day weekend. Since the holiday falls on a Sunday this year, grant money will be used to fund an increase in downtown patrols on Saturday, March 16th and Sunday, March 17th.
