

WEEKLY REPORT  
04/28/13-05/04/13

The weekend of Cinco de Mayo passed without any major incidents related to the celebration. Newark Police made 35 criminal arrests on May 4<sup>th</sup> and May 5<sup>th</sup> for numerous quality of life crimes (disorderly conduct, noise violations, etc.), and also trespassing, criminal mischief, and shoplifting crimes.

On May 5<sup>th</sup>, 2013 at approximately 12:30 a.m., Cpl. Barnes responded to the parking garage of the Washington House condominiums for a criminal mischief report. Two victims reported that their vehicle and motorcycle had sustained damage while they were parked. The motorcycle had been knocked on its side and oil and gasoline was spilling out. The victim's reported seeing a subject, later identified as Cody Greenlief (DOB 7/24/91), holding a tree branch near their vehicles as they walked towards them, and also observed remnants of a tree branch lodged in the motorcycle. The victims pointed out Greenlief to Cpl. Barnes, who was at the south end of the parking garage. Cpl. Barnes approached him and observed him urinating on another vehicle. Cpl. Barnes took Greenlief into custody without incident and, based upon his investigation, charged him with two counts of criminal mischief and disorderly conduct. He was released on \$1,500 unsecured bond.

Newark Police currently have felony warrants on file and are looking for James Earnest (DOB 7/24/1958). On May 7<sup>th</sup>, 2013 at approximately 3:00 a.m., Cpl. D'Elia responded for a report of a robbery in the 300 block of E. Delaware Circle. Cpl. D'Elia contacted the victim, who stated he was attacked by James Earnest and beaten with a blunt object. Earnest then took the victim's wallet, money and EBT card and fled in an unknown direction. A K9 officer responded for a track which yielded negative results. Earnest is currently being sought for robbery 1<sup>st</sup> degree, assault 2<sup>nd</sup> degree, and possession of a deadly weapon during the commission of a felony.
