

## WEEKLY REPORT

05/12/13-05/18/13

On May 19, 2013, the Newark Police Department arrested 31 year old Charles C. Word of Newark after he exposed himself this morning to a 22 year old female. On this date at approximately 6:15 a.m. the victim was walking southbound on South Chapel Street near Delaware Avenue when Word pulled over his vehicle, a Silver Dodge Charger, and asked the victim for directions. When the victim approached and looked into the vehicle she observed that Word's pants were down and that he was exposing his genitalia. The victim walked away from the vehicle which pulled away and turned left onto East Main Street. The victim continued to walk away and turned onto eastbound Delaware Avenue when Word pulled up to the victim a second time and attempted to engage her in conversation. Word then fled in his vehicle when the victim advised that she was calling the police. Using video surveillance cameras, NPD officers obtained the registration information for the vehicle and were able to positively identify Word as the driver. Officers responded to Word's residence and took him into custody without incident. Word was arrested on the below charges, arraigned through JP Court, and released on \$4,000 unsecured bail.
