**SUBJECT: NPD Arrests One for W. Main Street Burglary; Two Suspects Still Sought**

On Saturday, June 1<sup>st</sup>, 2013, at approximately 9:32 a.m., the Newark Police Department responded to the 300 block of W. Main Street in regards to a burglary that had occurred sometime during the previous week.

The victim (a 48 year old female) advised that her house had been unlawfully entered and that jewelry and two cast iron wood stoves had been removed. During a thorough investigation, officers were able to link three suspects to the burglary. One suspect was arrested and two suspects are still being actively sought by NPD.

**Defendant #1:** Michael Holtzman (DOB 11/26/1976) –arrested 6/6/13  
Homeless

**Charges:** Burglary 2<sup>nd</sup> degree  
Conspiracy 2<sup>nd</sup> degree  
Theft Under \$1,500  
Criminal Trespass 3<sup>rd</sup> degree

Holtzman received \$13,000 unsecured bond for the above charges and was committed to HRCYI due to a capias.

Homeless

**Suspect #3:** Thomas Kinsler (DOB 4/15/1984)
