

WEEKLY REPORT

On Saturday, July 13th, at 5:04 p.m., Newark Police Officers M/Cpl. Frank Gillespie, Cpl. Robert Vernon, Officer Ken Odom, and Officer William Anderson responded to a report of a house fire on East Park Place. Upon arriving at the scene, the officers observed a fire in the kitchen, caused by unattended cooking. As the flames began to work their way up the wall behind the stove, the officers each took turns running into the house, using fire extinguishers to fight the flames, and then running out of the house which was in near blackout condition due to the heavy smoke. The officers were able to extinguish the fire. Aetna Fire Chief John Rudd expressed his appreciation of the officers' actions. In a letter to Police Chief Tiernan, Chief Rudd wrote, "By their calm presence of mind and immediate actions, these Police Officers ensured that no civilian lives were in danger and saved the house from serious damage. Their actions reflected great credit upon themselves, upon the City of Newark, and were in keeping with the highest standards of public services provided by the Newark Police Department."

On Sunday, July 14th, at approximately 2:25 a.m., the Newark Police Department responded to the 700 block of Interchange Boulevard in regards to the theft of scrap metal that had just occurred. The reporting person advised that scrap metal was just stolen from a fenced in area outside his business. The value of the stolen scrap metal was reported to be \$1,000. Video surveillance of the incident showed a white Ford pickup truck drive up and park near the fence. Two suspects are seen exiting the truck and then cutting a hole in the fence. The suspects then load up the bed of the pick-up truck with air conditioning coils, and depart towards Elkton Road. Based on their investigation, NPD officers rapidly developed Kyle Mason as a suspect. NPD responded to Mason's Wilmington residence to conduct surveillance. While on location, NPD observed a white Ford F150 pull into the driveway. NPD officers then prepared search warrants for Mason's residence and vehicle. While executing the search warrants, NPD seized 12 air conditioning coils as well as tools used to cut metal. Mason was taken into custody without incident. The coils were turned back over to the business. Mason was arraigned in front of JP Court # 11 and released after posting \$601 secured bail.
