Last week, Deputy City Manager Andrew Haines, Chief Tiernan, and Lt. Feeney completed interviewing prospective candidates for the police officer position. On Saturday, November 23<sup>rd</sup>, Lt. Farrall will lead the team that administers the physical agility test to the top 20 ranked candidates.

On November 15<sup>th</sup>, Captain Williams and Lt. Feeney attended a Hazard Mitigation Plan Integration Workshop sponsored by DEMA and FEMA.

On November 18<sup>th</sup>, Chief Tiernan and Captain Williams attended a meeting of the New Castle County Local Emergency Planning Committee. Issues regarding training and transportation were discussed.

The Traffic Committee meeting was held on Tuesday, November 19<sup>th</sup>. The agenda consisted of a request for a signalized crosswalk on Main Street at Newark Deli & Bagel. Signalized crosswalks for Main Street and Delaware Avenue were discussed. Assistant Public Works & Water Resources Director Tom Coleman explained that funding for this request is included in the proposed 2014 capital budget. Traffic Committee members expressed their support of the project.

Last week, Newark Police charged a 29 year-old Dover woman with DUI and related charges after she struck a UDPD Officer, who was directing traffic on Delaware Avenue. The incident occurred at 2:26 p.m. Last month, two NPD officers were in an unmarked police car when they were struck from behind by a drunk driver. On October 12<sup>th</sup>, an elderly female passenger was killed as the car she was riding in on Christina Parkway was struck from the behind by a drunk driver. This driver also had prior DUI arrests.

The Newark Police Department, in cooperation with Aetna Hose Hook and Ladder Fire Company of Newark and the United States Marine Corps Reserve, is commencing the annual Toys for Tots Campaign. The Newark Police Department will be accepting donated gifts for children up to 12 years of age. A donation barrel is located in the lobby of the Newark Police Department at 220 South Main Street, where new unwrapped toys can be dropped off now until December 10<sup>th</sup>.

On the evening of Tuesday, December 17<sup>th</sup>, Santa Claus and Newark police officers, aboard a fire truck from the Aetna Hose Hook and Ladder Company, will deliver the gifts to deserving children in several Newark neighborhoods.
