SUBJECT: Newark Man Apprehended Following Burglaries

Newark Police have arrested 41 year old William D. Wilson 3rd, of Newark for burglary and attempted burglary of several homes in the unit block of East Cleveland Avenue on December 21st.

At approximately 10:07pm an observant citizen observed a suspicious male subject prowling in the rear of homes in the unit block of East Cleveland Avenue. An officer quickly responded to the scene and located the subject, later identified as Wilson as he walked along the sidewalk in front of the homes. The officer and witness observed Wilson discard a crow bar onto the ground as the officer approached. Wilson was taken into custody without incident.

During a subsequent investigation it was determined that Wilson had entered two homes and attempted to enter a third home, all in unit block of East Cleveland Avenue. Wilson was arrested on the burglary and related charges and arraigned through JP Court. He was committed to Howard R. Young Correctional in lieu of \$39,000 secured bail.
