On January 17, 2014, at approximately 10:50 a.m., Newark Police responded to the sidewalk in front of the Newark High School in regards to a strong-arm robbery that just occurred. The victim, a 21 year old male, advised officers that he was waiting for a DART bus when a short black male approached him and asked him to use his cell phone to call his mother. As the victim reached for his cell phone, the defendant punched him in the face, grabbed his iPhone, and then fled towards the College Square shopping center.

Officers viewed surveillance video from Newark High School and, through their investigation, were able to identify Andrew Jones-Matthew as the suspect. Hours after the incident, Newark Police, responded to Jones-Matthew's residence and took him into custody without incident. He was transported back to the Newark Police station and arraigned through Justice of the Peace Court 11 and released to the custody of his parents.

The majority of this week has been spent dealing with the snow storm and traffic related events. Many motorists were stranded trying to get home around noon on Tuesday. A video of M/Cpl. Paul Keld assisting a stranded motorist on Paper Mill Road was posted on the CNN and News Journal website. Several accidents were reported on Tuesday during the early rush of motorists attempting to drive home during the storm. Fortunately, most motorists stayed off the roads on Wednesday while road cleanup continued.
