SUBJECT: NPD Seek Public's Assistance Identifying Shoplift Suspects

The Newark Police Department is attempting to identify three suspects connected with a shoplifting incident that occurred at the Delaware Vision Center on East Main Street on February 6th, 2014.

At approximately 3:52pm the three suspects entered the vision center. Two of the suspects distracted store employees while the third suspect stole twelve pairs of eyeglasses valued at over \$2600. The suspects then left the store on foot in an unknown direction.

Suspect 1 is described as a light skinned black male, 25-35 years old, 6'01''-6'03'', thin build, 170-190 lbs., wearing a dark colored hat, dark colored jacket, and dark colored pants.

Suspect 2 is described as a light skinned black female, 50-60 years old, short black hair, dark puffy jacket, light blue jeans, knee high black boots and a large gap between her two front teeth.

Suspect 3 is described as a dark skinned black male, 25-35 years old, 5'09-5'11'', 190 lbs., beard and mustache, wearing a white construction hard hat, glasses, yellow reflective construction type vest, dark sweatshirt, and tan cargo pants.
