SUBJECT: Baltimore Man Arrested for Unlawful Sexual Contact with a Minor

Newark Police have arrested 23 year old, Robert Wright, of Baltimore, for Unlawful Sexual Contact with a 14 year old girl which occurred on March 3rd, 2014 at the Nuevo Inn located at 630 South College Avenue in the City of Newark.

The incident occurred shortly after midnight on March 3rd when Wright approached a 14 year old girl who was doing laundry in a third floor laundry room. Wright approached the girl in the laundry room and attempted to engage her in conversation. The girl left the room and entered an elevator to return to her room. Wright followed her onto the elevator and once inside made inappropriate sexual contact with her. When the elevator door opened, the female ran out and alerted her parents. Wright was located shortly after the incident in the TGIFridays restaurant and taken into custody without incident.

Wright was arraigned via JP Court #11 and released on \$3000 unsecured bond.
