

WEEKLY REPORT
03/30/14 to 04/05/14

Newark Police are investigating a fatal collision which occurred on April 4th, 2014 at approximately 10:15pm on Library Avenue (Route 72) just north of Farm Lane. A preliminary investigation has determined that a 2010 Hyundai Accent, operated by a 75 year old female was travelling southbound on Library Avenue when, for an unknown reason, it crossed the center line and ran head-on into a northbound 2000 Honda Civic, operated by a 24 year old female. The driver and sole occupant of the 2010 Hyundai Accent has been identified as Dorothy Hershman, of Newark. She was treated at the scene by rescue personnel and transported to Christiana Hospital where she was later pronounced deceased. The 24 year old female driver and 25 year old female passenger of the 2000 Honda Civic were also treated at the scene and transported to Christiana Hospital. Both sustained serious, but non-life threatening injuries. Route 72 was closed from Wyoming Road to Route 4 for approximately three hours while traffic investigators were on scene. No charges have been filed at this time and no further information on the collision is available at this time.

Susan Alfree and NPD officers are attending the Tribute and Candlelight Vigil taking place on April 9th, 2014 at Delaware State University as part of National Crime Victims' Rights Week. Susan Alfree is the Chair of the Planning Committee of the Delaware Victims' Rights Task Force and was instrumental in coordinating the ceremony.
