On March 23, 2014 at approximately 6:30 p.m., a male entered the State Line Cigarette Outlet on Elkton Road wearing a full face mask. The suspect lifted his shirt and showed the store clerk the handle of a black handgun and a knife clipped to the suspects pocket. The suspect demanded money from the cash register, which the clerk handed over. Newark Detective Greg D'Elia conducted the investigation and on Thursday April 10th, conducted a search warrant of a suspect's residence and seized evidence linking him to the robbery. The suspect was not home at the time of the search but turned himself in to police later that day. The handgun believed to be used in the robbery was recovered. The suspect was charged with Robbery 1st degree, Possession of a Deadly Weapon During the Commission of a Felony, Carrying a Concealed Deadly Weapon, and Wearing a Disguise During the Commission of a Felony.

On April 17th at 6:30 p.m., the Railroad Safety Presentation will be given at the Aetna Fire Station on Ogletown Road. The police department would like to especially thank Aetna Fire Chief A.J. Schall for being a panelist and also arranging the use of the fire station as well as making the physical preparations of the fire station for the public meeting. We would also like to thank New Castle County Emergency Management Coordinator Dave Carpenter for making arrangements with several presenters on the panel, as well as his own participation as a panelist.

Planning is underway to have additional police officers working grant funded overtime on May 3rd when Cinco de Mayo is often celebrated in Newark. This was also traditionally the day when Chapelfest used to be held.
