

## WEEKLY REPORT

04/13/14-04/19/14

On April 17, 2014, the Railroad Safety Meeting was held at the Aetna Fire House on Ogletown Road and was very well attended. Following the presentations, residents submitted questions which were answered by the panelists. Again, a special thanks to Councilwoman Marge Hadden for suggesting and arranging the presentation as well as gathering some of the panelists, City Manager Carol Houck for the support of city resources and her opening remarks, Aetna Fire Chief A.J. Schall for presenting and providing the use of the fire house, and New Castle County of Emergency Management Director Dave Carpenter for presenting and arranging for several other panelists that spoke.

The Newark Police Department has begun planning for Cinco de Mayo weekend, University of Delaware graduation and Newark Nite.

Newark Police have arrested three University of Delaware students after a home invasion occurred this weekend. On April 19, 2014, at approximately 2:00 a.m., three University of Delaware students entered an unlocked apartment complex in the unit block of Wrightstown Lane. After kicking through a locked bedroom door, three students (Andrew Lee, Jason Zimmell, Ayrton Doerr) assaulted a 22 year-old male University of Delaware student, who was in a bedroom with the resident, a 20 year-old female University of Delaware student. The suspects assaulted the male victim with multiple kicks, punches and a candle jar. The assault ended when a female roommate entered the bedroom and intervened. Neither of the females were assaulted.

Andrew Lee and the female resident previously had a casual relationship that had recently ended. All victims and suspects were known to each other. The 22 year-old male victim sustained a broken cheekbone, and required five stitches above his right eye, three below the right eye, and three staples on his head due to lacerations. He was treated at Christiana Hospital and released.

All three defendants turned themselves into NPD on April 21, 2014 to face the following charges:

- Home Invasion
- Possession of a Deadly Weapon During the Commission of a Felony
- Assault 2nd Degree
- Conspiracy 2nd Degree
- Criminal Mischief Under \$1,000

The defendants received \$46,500 secured bail which all posted and were subsequently released. They received a no-contact order with the victim of the assault and the resident of the apartment.
