

WEEKLY REPORT

On May 5, 2014, a suspect was arrested for a burglary at an acquaintances apartment, on Welsh Tract Road, where he stole a key and removed two TVs and a computer. During an inventory of his property, a stolen credit card belonging to another neighbor was located. The suspect admitted entering the victim's unlocked apartment and stealing her purse. He later used the victim's credit card to make purchases. The suspect was also arrested for stealing a Kindle and money from another acquaintance, on Welsh Tract Road.

The suspect was committed on \$24,000 secured and given no contact orders with all of the victims, meaning he cannot return to his apartment if he is released.

Newark Police have arrested 31 year old Jeffrey Walker, of New Castle, for the April 16th bomb threat at Porter Auto Group. The incident began at approximately 5:23 p.m. on April 16th when an unknown suspect called in a bomb threat at an unspecified Porter Auto Group location on East Cleveland Avenue. Four Porter Auto Group buildings were evacuated and K-9 teams from DSP and UDPD swept the buildings for explosives. An investigation determined that the threat was unfounded. Cleveland Avenue was closed in both directions from Capitol Trail to Paper Mill Road for approximately 90 minutes.

During the subsequent investigation, detectives learned that Walker, a former sub-contractor for the Porter Auto Group, had recently been terminated. He was linked to the crime using phone records. He was arrested after detectives executed a search warrant at his residence.

Walker was charged with 1 count of Terroristic Threatening Causing a Building Evacuation and was arraigned at JP Court #2 and released on \$2,000 unsecured bail.

Officers were busy on Saturday May 3rd, due to many people celebrating Cinco de Mayo. Extra officers worked grant funded overtime to assist patrol in keeping areas in order. Officers issued a total of 14 citations, 9 noise warnings and have warrants pending for six additional charges.

The traffic control order has been issued for the Memorial Day Parade on May 18th. The ceremony will take place on the green and will begin at 1:00 p.m., followed by the parade beginning at 2:00 p.m. Officers will be assigned to traffic posts assisting with traffic detours.

Detectives are continuing to investigate the incident on Whitherspoon Lane that occurred on May 1st. Police received a report at 3:30 p.m. that two groups were firing guns at each other. Upon arriving at the scene, police recovered several shell casings and one handgun.
