

WEEKLY REPORT

On Monday, June 2<sup>nd</sup>, three detectives were approved for funding to attend specialized training through the Delaware Criminal Justice Council VAWA Law Enforcement Training Program. The trainings will focus on Domestic Violence, Sexual Assault and Stalking investigations.

On Tuesday, June 3<sup>rd</sup>, detectives arrested Joshua Eckerd for a burglary to one residence and attempted burglary to a second residence on West Chestnut Hill Road. The crime was originally committed in mid-May. Detectives were able to link the burglaries to others being investigated by the County Police. Eckerd was charged with Burglary 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree, Attempted Burglary 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree, Theft over \$1500 and two counts of Criminal Mischief. He was turned over to the Department of Correction in lieu of \$22,200 cash bail.

On Tuesday, June 3<sup>rd</sup>, officers arrested James Clayton on multiple charges stemming from the theft of several bicycles. Officers responded to a report of a bicycle stolen from in front of a business on East Main Street. The officers were able to observe the incident on the downtown camera system and obtain a suspect description. A while later, the 911 center received a call stating that there were subjects on East Cleveland Avenue who appeared to be stealing bicycles. Officers responded to the area and were able to stop the described vehicle, which contained five stolen bicycles in the truck bed. The passenger of the vehicle was identified as the same suspect seen on the downtown cameras and identified as James Clayton. Clayton was arrested for one count of Theft and four counts of Receiving Stolen Property. He was released on \$5,000 unsecured bail.

On Wednesday, June 4<sup>th</sup>, at approximately 1:34 a.m. officers responded to a report of a single vehicle collision on Capitol Trail near Orchard Road. Officers made contact with the driver of the vehicle, identified as Ronald Hazzard. The investigation determined that Hazzard struck a curb disabling the vehicle and he had been drinking. Hazzard was charged with his 7<sup>th</sup> Offense DUI, Driving While Suspended and Careless Driving. He was committed to the Department of Correction in lieu of \$20,501 cash bail.
