University of Delaware Alumni Weekend passed without any major incidents. While foot traffic was above normal for a June weekend, there were no serious issues. New Night Downtown is the next major event in Newark. The Newark Police Department plans to have a strong presence so everyone can enjoy the event without incident as well.

Newark Police sent out a press release on June 9th seeking the public's assistance in identifying a strong-arm robbery suspect. On May 23rd at approximately 10:50 a.m., the suspect attempted to leave Walgreen's (216 Suburban Drive) with a pack of diapers. Upon being confronted by an employee, the suspect initially gave the diapers back to the store clerk, but then wrestled the diapers out of the employee's grasp. The suspect fled in a maroon, older model Pontiac vehicle, possibly with NJ registration.
