Joshua facilitated the discussion between police personnel and the vendor and with the new software it appears we will be able to greatly improve our data collection.

Recruit Graber and Recruit Heath are attending their final weeks of training at the Delaware State Police Academy. The graduation ceremony will be held in Dover on July 11th. City Manager Carol Houck, Deputy City Manager Andrew Haines, Chief Paul Tiernan, and police staff will be in attendance.
