SUBJECT: Newark Police Arrest Two for Committing Lewd Act on Roof Above Chipotle

On July 12th at approximately 9:40 PM, Newark Police responded to the 100 block of East Main Street after receiving multiple reports about two people engaging in sexual intercourse on the roof above Chipotle. An NPD officer arrived and, while on the opposite side of the street, clearly observed the two defendants engaging in sexual intercourse on the roof at the very front of the Chipotle building. The officer advised them to stop and they continued for approximately 15-20 seconds before stopping. The officer told them they were under arrest and they fled from the roof into a defendant's apartment located at 132 East Main Street. After NPD located both defendants at the apartment, they were both taken into custody without further incident.

Both defendants were released after receiving \$1,800 unsecured bond for the below charges.
