

## WEEKLY REPORT

On May 12<sup>th</sup> at approximately 3:15 a.m., Master Corporal Jay Conover initiated a traffic stop for a motor vehicle violation. As a result of the stop, two females were arrested for possession of 133 bags of heroin, 4 grams of crack cocaine, and seven grams of marijuana. One of the women also had outstanding warrants. As the investigation continued, it was determined that the two women were working as prostitutes out of a local hotel. A male was subsequently arrested for promoting prostitution and endangering the welfare of a child who was present while the prostitution was taking place. This was a great investigation led by Master Corporal Conover and the members of C platoon.

We continue to receive reports of telephone scams. Most recently, a female resident received a call from an unknown person stating that the resident's brother had been involved in a motor vehicle accident involving a gang member. The resident was instructed to wire \$1,600 via Western Union or her brother would be killed. The caller also stated they were in possession of her brother's cell phone and if she tried to call it, they would kill him. After the money was wired, the resident received a phone call stating that her brother was released. When the brother was contacted, he stated he was shopping and had not been involved in an accident. The money transfer was tracked to Puerto Rico.

Arrangements are in place for this weekend's Memorial Day Parade, and for the upcoming Newark Night.
