SUBJECT OF PRESS RELEASE

Newark Police Departmental Collision Rt 4 and Rt 72

On Friday, May 22, 2015 at approximately 7:30 pm a Newark Police unit was responding to the Brookside development to assist New Castle County Police with a burglary in progress complaint involving weapons. The Newark Police car was travelling east bound on Route 4 and entered the intersection with Route 72. A vehicle (blue Mazda 3) was travelling north bound on route 72 entered the intersection at the same time and was struck by the Newark Police vehicle. The Mazda's driver and only occupant in addition to the Newark Police officer were both transport to Christiana Hospital with non-life threatening injuries.

The Newark Police Traffic Unit is on scene conducting the investigation.

The intersection is open but some delays should be expected while the investigators are on scene.

No further details are known at this time.
