

## WEEKLY REPORT

With the return of the university students our calls for service and activity have increased significantly, as occurs each fall. There have been numerous arrests for under age consumption of alcohol, drinking alcohol in public, disorderly conduct, and disorderly premises.

On August 30, 2015, an 18 year old student was found lying in the street suffering from an alcohol overdose. Due to his high level of intoxication, no information could be gathered from the subject, however officers were able to locate identification on his person. Paramedics treated the student at the scene and he was transported to Christiana Emergency Room for further treatment.

Each weekend additional officers will be patrolling the downtown area using grant funded overtime.

Our four new police recruits are working with their field training officers and progressing very well. We have four additional recruits who began work this week. We are proud to welcome Jon Lee, Ashton Poblarp, Tiffani Hughes, and Ryan Hastings. They will begin training at the Delaware State Police Academy on September 14<sup>th</sup>, with an expected graduation early in 2016.

Chief Tiernan and the Deputy Police Chiefs, met with the department administrative staff on September 3<sup>rd</sup>. Some topics discussed included police response and activity for the remainder of the year as well as planning, staffing, and activities in 2016.
