SUBJECT OF PRESS RELEASE

Burglary with Arrest

On Sunday, September 20, 2015 at about 05:14 a.m., Newark Police responded to a residence in the 100 block of Kristins Way for the report of a burglary in progress. When officers arrived, they found the occupants detaining the defendant (John M. McCormick) who had entered the house through the unlocked front door. Once inside, while gathering items to steal, he woke up one of the residents. The resident yelled out to his roommates who helped in detaining McCormick until the police arrived.

The victims are a male (21) and a male (19) both University of Delaware Students. The other occupants, also UD students, were guests of the victims.

McCormick was charged as follows and is committed to the Howard R. Young Correctional Institute in lieu of \$5,800.00 secured bond.
