Newark Police Investigate a Robbery on the Pomeroy Trail

The Newark Police Department is investigating a robbery that occurred on Monday, 11/09/2015, at approximately 11:00 PM.

The female victim (26), who was walking alone, had entered the Pomeroy Trail near East Cleveland Ave and Papermill Road. As she neared the area of Kershaw Street she was approached from behind by the suspect who was armed with a handgun. The suspect demanded her purse and cell phone then fled on foot toward Papermill Road. The victim returned to her home and called the police. The victim was not injured during this incident.

The suspect is described as a black male, 18 to 35 years old, 5"08" to 5'10", average build, dark pants, and a dark bandana covering his face.

The victim is not a University of Delaware Student.
There are no pictures or video available.
