## **Newark Police Arrest Man for Violation of Privacy**

On November 21<sup>st</sup>, Newark Police responded to the Iron Hill Brewery for a report of a suspicious person in the bathroom. Officers were advised of a white male that had been observed in the female bathroom at that location on several occasions. Employees stated that the male hides in the stalls and unscrews the lights to darken the area around him. The suspect was not on scene when officers arrived.

On November 28<sup>th</sup>, Newark Police responded to Iron Hill for a similar report. Officers were able to contact the subject and they identified him as Stephen Sackett. After investigating both incidents, Stephen Sackett was arrested on December 4<sup>th</sup>.

Defendant 1: Stephen Sackett (age 29)

Sackett was released on \$750.00 unsecured bond.
