Newark, DE- Jennifer Wallace, Luke Chapman and Stu Markham will officially be sworn in as City Council Members, and Polly Sierer as Mayor for the new term on Thursday, April 21, 2016 at 6:00 p.m. in the City Council Chamber.

Mayor Sierer and Councilman Markham ran unopposed during this election, while Wallace ran against by Arlynn Hall and Chapman was challenged by Donna Means. Unofficial polling results are as follows:
