## **Newark Police Department Investigating Bank Robbery**

*Update: Arrest Made*

May 20, 2016 – Newark Police arrested Jabari Beeks on May 18<sup>th</sup>, 2016 for the robbery of WSFS that occurred on April 11<sup>th</sup>. Beeks was taken into custody in Wilmington in the 900 block of North Adams Street by the Wilmington Police Department after fleeing on foot from members of Wilmington PD, Newark PD, Delaware State Police and FBI agents.

Beeks was transported to Howard R. Young Correctional Institution in lieu of \$60,000 cash bond and \$1,000 secured bond.

**Newark Police Department Investigating Bank Robbery**

April 12, 2016 – Newark Police are investigating a bank robbery that occurred on April 11<sup>th</sup> at approximately 3:30pm at WSFS, located at 201 Suburban Drive. A male suspect entered the bank and presented the teller with a note demanding cash while implying he was armed. After the teller handed over an undisclosed amount of money, the suspect fled out the front door and was last seen running northbound on Hamlet Way. A K9 track of the area yielded negative results.

The suspect is further described as a black male, between 25-35 years of age, approximately 5 feet 11 inches to 6 feet 1 inches, 170-190 lbs, muscular build, wearing black framed glasses, a black baseball hat, a black Nike sweatshirt with neon yellow/green trim, white and black running shoes, and light grey sweat pants.

No surveillance footage is available at this time.
