New Traffic Signal Coming to E. Main Street

Newark, DE - Pedestrians and motorists in downtown Newark will soon experience safer and smoother travels. A new traffic signal has been installed at the pedestrian crossing located at E. Main Street and The Green at the University of Delaware. The signal will be on 72-hour flash beginning Thursday, August 18 at 9 a.m. It will then transition to stop and go operation on Monday, August 22 at 9 a.m.

The signal will be coordinated with the signal located at South College Avenue. This will allow for defined breaks in vehicle traffic for pedestrians to cross safely, and defined breaks in pedestrian traffic for vehicles to pass efficiently.
