SYNOPSIS: ON 06-06-08 at 0201 hours a bicycle operated by a 24-year-old Wilmington man collided with a Toyota driven by a 22-year-old female of Wilmington. The bicycle was travelling the wrong way (Westbound) in the bike lane on E. Delaware Ave. As he approached S. College Ave. he attempted to make a left turn. The operator of the bicycle stated that he could not stop in time when he saw a vehicle enter the intersection and collided with it. The operator of the Toyota stated that she never saw the bicycle coming and just heard it when it struck the front right corner panel of the car. The operator of the bicycle was transported and treated at C.E.R. where it was determined that he sustained a broken arm. He was charged with travelling the wrong way on a one- way street and operating a bicycle at night without a light.
