SUBJECT: Residential Burglaries

The Newark Police Department is investigating four residential burglaries that occurred in the same area of the City over the past weekend. All four houses are in the southern end of the City, and all four are along the Christina Creek. The burglaries appear to have all occurred during daylight hours.

In all instances, entry was gained by breaking a window in the rear of the house. Once inside, the suspect(s) have searched the housed, but no items of significant value have been stolen. Currency consisting of loose coin has been taken.

There are no known suspects. Residents of that area of Newark are cautioned to be alert to suspicious persons, especially in the rear yards of houses at residences along the creek. Any questionable activity should be immediately reported to the police.
