The Newark Police Department is hosting the **10th Citizens Police Academy** scheduled to begin on **September 17th, 2008** and operate through **November 12th, 2008**. The program is designed to give citizens, whom are interested in learning about law enforcement, a unique opportunity to observe firsthand the various duties and responsibilities of a police officer. Anyone over the age of 18 years may apply and there is no cost to attend the program. The program meets every Wednesday evening between 6:30 pm and 10:00 pm for a total of 10 classes in 9 weeks.
