SUBJECT: Arrest for Theft of Vehicle from Dealership

On November 2, 2008 at 1:00 a.m. a security guard working at Porter Used Cars, 300 E. Cleveland Ave, Newark, observed a car being backed out of a space on the lot. The guard positioned her vehicle to prevent the car from being moved. The person attempting to steal the car abandoned the vehicle and ran off toward the former Cleveland Heights complex.

A responding Newark Police officer saw the suspect running on Terrace Drive. A Newark Police K-9 team went to that area and found the suspect hiding in the brush along a tree line. He was taken into custody without incident.

The car the suspect was attempting to steal was a 2006 Infiniti M35 valued at \$30,000.
