SUBJECT: Indecent Exposure Arrest

The Newark Police Department has charged Derek Maloney with Indecent Exposure and Lewdness after he exposed his genitals to three female victims in public places within a short period of time. On Thursday January 22, reports were received of a person exposing himself to passing pedestrians near Elkton Road and Amstel Avenue, Newark. A responding officer saw Maloney walking on the railroad tracks in that area. Maloney was detained, and was positively identified by one of the victims.

During the investigation, two other female victims complained that Maloney had also exposed himself to them on North College Avenue near Cleveland Avenue.

The investigation revealed that Maloney exposed his genitals to the females as they walked near him, and he would make motions with his hands indicating he was fondling himself. Maloney was charged with three counts of Lewdness and two counts of Indecent Exposure. He was committed to the Howard Young Correctional Facility in default of bond.
