SUBJECT: "Bang" Graffiti Arrest

The Newark Police Department announces the arrest of Joseph T. Pawley. Pawley is a graffiti vandal charged with tagging "Bang" on the base of the Apple Road Bridge in Newark.

He was arrested on July 9 and charged with one count each of Graffiti, Possession of Graffiti Implements, Trespassing, and Conspiracy 3rd Degree. The Trespassing charge indicates that Pawley trespassed on the property of CSX Railroad in order to access the bridge. The Conspiracy charge reflects that Pawley acted with another person, that being the previously-arrested Keanan Connell (SKUM). Pawley was released on \$1,350.00 unsecured bond.
