

WEEKLY REPORT

6/28-7/4/09

Recently, Officer Adam Stevens was dispatched to a call of a theft of items from an unlocked car that was parked overnight. A GPS Unit, a faceplate for a car stereo and other items were stolen from inside the vehicle. Unfortunately, this is a common occurrence in this area. The victim had graduated from high school and will be attending college in the fall. The victim works to pay for her car, vehicle insurance, and the other items that were stolen and cost the victim two weeks salary to purchase the GPS unit. Officer Stevens did not treat this as a routine incident and quickly conducted an interview with the victim for possible suspects. Based on the interview, he was able to track down a group of people who were suspected of selling drugs and were also involved in other crimes. Officer Stevens with the assistance of Cpl. Micolucci tracked down the suspect, recovered the stolen property and made the arrest in a matter of hours. Also recovered, was stolen property from other vehicle thefts. This is another example of the excellent work done by our patrol officers and the reason why residents are supportive of the police.

On July 5th, Sgt. Simpson, Cpl. Kendrick, and Cpl. Micolucci were dispatched to a call of a suspicious male on a back porch of a vacant house located on Corbit Street. Cpl. Kendrick recognized the male as having active warrants from Newark. Sgt. Simpson observed the suspect discard a bag of marijuana on the ground. A search of the suspect found additional marijuana and a knife. The suspect was charged with the drug offense and carrying a concealed deadly weapon. He was committed to the Howard Young Correctional Facility.

On July 6th, Sgt. Simpson and PO Stevens were dispatched to a domestic dispute on O' Daniel Avenue. Upon arriving at the scene, Sgt. Simpson observed the suspect at the rear of his vehicle with a box of ammunition in his hand and a handgun box. Sgt. Simpson secured the suspect and recovered a handgun from the suspect's waistband. The suspect had been arguing with his pregnant girlfriend and pushed her to the ground prior to returning to his car and opening his trunk. Chief Tiernan arrived on the scene as Sgt. Simpson and PO Stevens were seizing the handgun. Both officers acted in a calm and professional manner in what could have escalated into a tragic situation.
