

WEEKLY REPORT

7/12-7/18/09

On July 17th, Newark Police officers responded to the rear parking lot of 45 East Main Street for a report of a man armed with a gun. Upon arriving at the scene, officers were met by the victims. The victim told the officers that they had a verbal dispute with a male and a female inside Kildare's Irish Pub. The argument escalated to the parking lot at which time the suspect walked to a parked car and removed a handgun from the trunk and placed it in the waistband of his pants and began to approach the victims. The female accompanying the suspect convinced him to leave the scene. The officer ascertained the license plate number of the suspect's vehicle. Officer Stevens located the vehicle and the suspect at the 7-11 store on Delaware Avenue. The suspect was found to have two loaded handguns in the vehicle. He was charged with carrying a concealed deadly weapon. The female passenger was arrested for an outstanding warrant from Court 40.

On July 17th, a victim responded to the Newark Police Department to report that three males armed with handguns threatened to shoot him on East Cleveland Avenue. The victim is familiar with two of the suspects. Officer Stevens is investigating.

On July 21st, Newark Police Officers responded to a report of an assault in the area of 51 East Main Street. Upon arriving at the scene, officers found two men that had been beaten unconscious. Officers determine that two groups had been involved in an argument in Grotto's Pizza. The bouncers removed both groups. Once outside one group began to beat the two victims to the ground and continued to beat them unconscious. The two victims were transported to Christiana Hospital. Officer Mease is investigating.
