

WEEKLY REPORT

7/19-7/25/09

On July 24th, officers responded to a domestic incident involving a man waving a gun in an apartment on Madison Drive. The victim reported that a male known to her, entered the residence and waved a handgun in front of her and her children, while making threats. The suspect ran out the rear door prior to the police arriving. Officers spotted the suspect driving near the intersection of Route 4 and 72. The suspect refused to stop his vehicle and fled from the scene. The suspect's vehicle was found abandoned near Lehigh Road. The suspect was located and arrested in an alley in the rear of Madison Drive. He was charged with Burglary, Aggravated Menacing, Aggravated Assault, Reckless Endanger, Possession of a Deadly Weapon, and numerous other charges.

On July 27th, another suspect was arrested for graffiti. He was charged with four (4) counts of graffiti and four (4) counts of possession of graffiti implements. He was released on \$1,800 bond. More arrests are expected.

The Newark Police Department is continuing to investigate the shooting death that occurred in a city motel room. One arrest warrant has been issued for a suspect in custody. The investigation is continuing and will involve multiple states and agencies.
