The Criminal Investigation Division continues to work on the two open homicide cases that occurred in the city. Mike Van Campen has been temporarily reassigned from patrol to CID, to assist Det. Fred Nelson in one of the homicide investigations.

On Tuesday, August 11th, Officer Greg Micolucci observed a suspicious vehicle on Marrows Road. Upon checking the vehicle registration, he developed probable cause that the operator was a known gang member with outstanding warrants and has a history of resisting arrest. Upon conducting the motor vehicle stop, the suspect fled from the vehicle on foot. The suspect is wanted for: Criminal Impersonation, Resisting Arrest, Violation of Probation, Failure to Appear, and other charges.

The 2009 Fall Crime Suppression Initiative begins on August 14th. The return of the University of Delaware students usually results in an increase of street crime during the months of August through November. Detectives, K-9 officers, and Traffic officers have been reassigned to assist the patrol division in preventing these crimes. Street Crime Unit officers will be aggressively patrolling in unmarked vehicles. On weekend evenings beginning in September, the Newark Police Department Mobile Command Post will be stationed in the area of off campus student housing.
