

## WEEKLY REPORT

8/9-8/15/09

The Fall Crime Initiative began this past weekend. Officers were deployed in the downtown and off campus housing areas of the city. Numerous people were arrested for underage consumption of alcohol, open containers of alcohol, and one person was arrested for driving under the influence of alcohol.

On Saturday, August 15<sup>th</sup> at 9:10 a.m., an armed robbery was committed at the Rite Aid Pharmacy on New London Road. The suspect displayed a silver handgun that was tucked inside his waistband. A note was passed demanding prescription drugs. The previous day, a similar robbery occurred at a Rite Aid store just outside city limits.

On Tuesday, August 18<sup>th</sup> at 8:54 a.m., officers responded to a report of a possible burglary on West Hawthorn Road. Upon arriving at the scene, the suspect jumped through a screened window. Officers chased the suspect on foot and apprehended him in the area of Ogletown Road and Marrows Road. The suspect was charged with numerous offenses including, Criminal Trespass, Trespassing on Railroad Tracks, Criminal Mischief, and resisting arrest. He was committed to the Howard Young Correctional Facility.

On Tuesday, August 18<sup>th</sup> at 5:06 a.m., a one-vehicle collision occurred at Elkton Road and West Main Street. The vehicle was driven northeast on Elkton Road toward Delaware Avenue when the operator failed to make the turn onto Delaware Avenue and drove over the traffic island, and continued in the wrong direction on the one-way portion of Elkton Road. The vehicle traveled to the intersection of West Main Street where it struck a utility pole. The impact of the collision sheared the pole into two pieces and brought down the attached wires. The driver sustained minor injuries and was treated and released from Christiana Hospital. The driver was charged with Inattentive Driving, Driving the Wrong Way on a One-Way Street, Disregarding a Traffic Control Device, and Driving While License Suspended.
