

## WEEKLY REPORT

8/23-8/29/09

Following the third week of the Fall Crime Initiative, which began on August 14<sup>th</sup>, there have been no incidents of street robbery or aggravated assault. The following arrests made just last week in the initiative zone are as follows: 14 criminal arrests, 4 drug arrests, 23 alcohol arrests, and 2 Driving Under the Influence arrests.

On Thursday, August 27<sup>th</sup>, Newark Police Detective Nick Sansone and members of the Delaware State Police have arrested two suspects in the recent Rite Aid robberies. Both suspects were committed to Gander Hill.

On Saturday, August 29<sup>th</sup>, the Newark Police Mobile Command Post was stationed on Main Street for freshmen move-in day. Chief Tiernan, Captain Williams and Lt. Stanko staffed the command post. City of Newark informational brochures, city maps and maps of Downtown Newark businesses were distributed. In addition, two police officers patrolled Main Street on foot. Many parents expressed their appreciation of police presence and assistance.

Cpl. Jeff Schwagel arrested a suspect that painted the tag "KARP" and charged him with 23 graffiti related charges. The suspect was released to his mother pending a Family Court hearing. Cpl. Schwagel also arrested a second suspect for painting the tag "RAD" in the city. The suspect was released on \$4,000 bail pending arraignment.

On Tuesday, September 2<sup>nd</sup>, Cpl. Marty LaRue arrested three suspects after they broke into a car on O' Daniel Avenue, removed a stereo and entered the Christina Mill apartment complex. Cpl. LaRue stopped the suspects as they were driving through the apartment complex, arrested them and recovered the stolen property.

The number of traffic summonses issued continues to decline as Traffic Officers have temporarily been assigned to the Fall Crime Initiative and then will be assigned to patrol in order to fill vacant officer positions.
