

## WEEKLY REPORT

9/20-9/26/09

To date, the Fall Crime Initiative statistics reveal there have been no robberies. During the week indicated above, the following arrests were made: 9 criminal arrests, 3 drug arrests, 6 noise violation arrests, 14 alcohol arrests and 2 driving under the influence arrests.

On Friday, September 25<sup>th</sup>, at 10:15 p.m., Officer Adam Stevens stopped a suspicious male on Main Street. The suspect was found in be in possession of a large knife and was arrested for possession of a concealed deadly weapon. He was released on \$2,000 unsecured bail.

On Sunday, September 27<sup>th</sup>, at 12:56 a.m., a female patron of Grotto's Pizza became involved in an argument with a male patron. During the argument, the male spilled beer on the female. The female's brother intervened and the suspect struck the brother in the face on fled on foot. The female was very intoxicated and was unable to provide any further information.

The Criminal Justice Council awarded the Newark Police Department grant funding for the Victim Services Coordinator position for the year 2010.

The United States Department of Justice awarded the Newark Police Department over \$100,000 for closed circuit cameras to be placed in high crime and disturbance areas. On Tuesday, September 29<sup>th</sup>, Chief Tiernan and Captain Williams travelled to the Bayonne Police Department (NJ) to observe their CCTV camera system.
