

WEEKLY REPORT

10/18-10/24/09

On Saturday, October 24th three armed robberies occurred. The first robbery occurred on Willa Road. A suspect pulled to the side of the road and put an object into the victim's stomach. The victim turned over his cell phone and then the suspect took the victim's wallet. The suspect was described as a black male 6'0" with a medium to dark complexion, and was seen driving a silver 4-door sedan that appeared to be a Dodge or Chrysler. This was reported late at 1000 hours to the Police Department.

The second robbery occurred on Wyoming Road near the Christina bus yard. A suspect approached a 20-year old University of Delaware student on foot and demanded his wallet and phone. The suspect was described as a black male, 5'10" in his late twenties wearing a light brown or tan hoody. The suspect fled after getting into the side door of a passenger vehicle. (No further description)

The third robbery occurred at the corner of Margaret Street and Annabelle Street. A suspect approached a 19 year-old female University of Delaware student and two males on foot. The suspect produced a handgun and demanded the female victim's purse. One of the male witnesses pushes the suspect and suspect puts a gun to the witness's side. The witness grabs the gun and realizes it is fake. The suspect threatens to shoot the witness and the witness tells him he knows gun is fake. The suspect enters the rear passenger seat of a vehicle parked on Margaret Street that flees in reverse heading northbound. The suspect is described as a white male, 18-22 years of age, average build, short hair, 5'10", wearing an oversized white hoody. The vehicle is described as a maroon or dark red, 4-door in the 1990's. The gun was described as black, plastic, with a long barrel.

On Thursday, October 29th, the Newark Police Department will meet with representatives from various police agencies to finalize plans for the upcoming University of Delaware homecoming.
